

MVAT & Autosolo/Production Car Regulations

TDC are involved in running club motorsport events for everyone. As such, the club expect that the 'spirit' of the regulations listed below are interpreted the way they are intended. Events held solely on private ground do not need NCT or Tax, however the vehicle must be capable of being driven on the road day or night in all weather.

Competing Vehicles in Trials Drivers Club Multi Venue Autotests & Autosolos must comply with the following:

1. Body

- 1 Body shape must be as original and retain the original layout of engine and transmission; all body panels must be retained with the original dimensions and position. Panels and/or bodyshell cannot be 'gutted' of internal bracing.
- 2 Bumpers must be retained exception: metal bumpers may be removed from retro cars for safety reasons.
- 3 All windows must remain as the original specified dimensions and position. Glass windscreen must be retained. Front windows must be capable of being slid open, lowered by electronic or manual winding. Front wipers must be retained.
- 4 All lighting units fitted ex-factory must be fully retained and working.
- 5 All cars with non structural roof must have a roll bar fitted (not style bar).

2. Vehicle interior

- 6 All major internal trim as fitted to the body type by its original manufacturer must be retained, with the exception of the following **only**:
 - Carpets
 - Radio / speakers
 - Headlining
 - rear seat(s)
 - all boot trim.
 - ¼ panel trims
- 7 Front seats and belts may be improved passenger seat must be retained.
- 8 Air bags may be removed or disabled

All vehicles are **strongly advised** to carry a small spill kit and a 'Fire Stick'

3. Tyres

- 9 Tyres from Lists 1B or 1C are <u>not</u> permitted. Tyres used must be chosen from <u>1A only</u>. Current MSA list refers.
- 10 "Retro cars" are defined as vehicles produced before 01.01.1980 may use A021R tyres due to the lack of availability of suitable alternatives.

4. Engines

11 Engines up to 1250cc may now have forced induction provided it was sold as such by the original manufacturer.
